

Kartright Speedway Club Rules (LR: 19 Jan 2012)

1.0 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 These Rules (hereafter called the "Club Rules") are formulated by The Management. The Club Rules shall apply to all members, guests and visitors using the Club's facilities.
- 1.2 The Management in accordance with the Club Constitution will deal with any contravention of the Rules by members or their guests.
- 1.3 The Rules may be revoked, amended or added by the Management at any time as may be deemed necessary. Members will be notified of any alterations to the Rules through available Club communication channels such as the website and notices. An updated copy shall be kept available at the Main Reception for any member to refer to at all times. Ignorance of any Rule will not be accepted by the Management as an excuse for contravention by a member or guest.
- 1.4 The Management may suspend the operation of any Rules upon such special occasions and upon such terms and conditions as they consider, either by notification on the Club's notice board, website or other means deemed suitable.

2.0 GENERAL RULES

- 2.1 Members shall at all times behave in an exemplary manner. It is also the responsibility of members to ensure that their guests adhere to the Club Rules and that their behaviour and conduct are above reproach at all times.
- 2.2 Members shall be responsible for the behaviour and conduct of their guests.
- 2.3 Club officials or employees may ask any person who is not appropriately attired to leave the Club's facilities and/or the Club's premises.

2.4 The operating hours of the Club and its facilities are prescribed as below:

The Management may change the operating hours at its discretion upon prior notice to members on the website. The track availability will also be reflected on the website.



- 2.5 All forms of gambling are prohibited in the Club.
- 2.6 All members and guests should refrain from physically or verbally abusing any other members or employees of the Club. Use of vulgarities is strictly prohibited in the Club.
- 2.7 Members shall produce their NRIC, driver's licence or other proof of identity if requested to do so for verification by the Club.
- 2.8 The Club Management may prohibit the use of items that it deems objectionable or likely to cause a nuisance or danger to members' or Club's property.
- 2.9 Serving of Food Catering at the lounge area / viewing gallery is subjected to approval. Food and drinks are prohibited in the Gymnasium.
- 2.10 Consumption and serving of Alcoholic drinks are strictly prohibited in the club.
- 2.11 Members wishing to use any part of the Club's premises for private events may liaise with the Club management at least two weeks prior to the date subjected to all terms and conditions that apply.

- 2.12 Members making applications for private events shall be responsible to pay to the Club the costs and expenses incurred as charged by the Club.
- 2.13 The Club shall not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any article brought into the Club by a member or his/her guest(s). (Club Constitution Article 19.1).
- 2.14 The Club shall not be responsible for the death of or injury to any member, his/her guest(s) or any other person while they are in the Club. (Club Constitution Article 19.2).
- 2.15 Members shall be liable for any damage to the Club's property caused by themselves or their guests and may be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the Club Constitution. The Management, whose decision shall be final, shall determine the amount of such costs.
- 2.16 No furniture or any other Club's property shall be removed from the Club without the approval of the Management (Club Constitution Article 13.2).

2.17 Littering is strictly prohibited.

2.18 Members and guests under 18 years old are not allowed to enter the following areas, without the accompany of adults:

- (a) Gymnasium

2.19 No animals or pets are allowed to be brought into the Club's facilities.

2.20 Members failing to register their guests are liable to a fine of up to 10 times the guest fee.

2.21 Each member may bring a maximum of three guests, except otherwise stated in the Club Rules. Members who wish to introduce more than the maximum stipulated number of guests at any one time shall notify the management at least one working day in advance.

2.22 Members shall accompany their guests at all times.

2.23 Children below the age of 5 years old are strictly prohibited to enter the Pit lane area, unless prior approval has been sought from the management.

2.24 Members and/or guests may be asked to leave the Club's premises by any Club official if their behaviour or conduct causes annoyance to other members.

2.25 Smoking is strictly prohibited in air-conditioned facilities and in the following areas:

- (a) Gymnasium
- (b) Lounge / Viewing Gallery
- (c) Pit lane

It will also be in accordance all NEA regulations and law of Singapore. Smoking will only be allowed at designated areas.

2.26 Members are required to make payment for all dues by the stipulated due date as stated on the monthly statement of account.

2.27 If payment is not received by the payment due date, a late payment interest charge of 1.5% per month will be levied on all outstanding. All costs incurred by the Club to recover outstanding debts will be charged to the member.

3.0 KARTING BYE-LAWS

3.1 RACE KARTS RULES & REGULATIONS

No pretence is made of having designed a foolproof set of rules and regulations.

Motorsports is dangerous.

The reference Kartright Speedway refers to The Track and its related companies, employees and appointed officials. Any member not complying with the guidelines may be banned from future activities. **The decision of Kartright Speedway is FINAL.**

The rules and regulations set forth herein are designed to provide for the orderly conduct of racing events and to establish minimum acceptable requirements for all racing and practice events. By participating in these events all competitors, crews and spectators are deemed to have complied with these rules. No expressed or implied warranty of safety shall result from the publication or compliance with these rules and/or regulations.

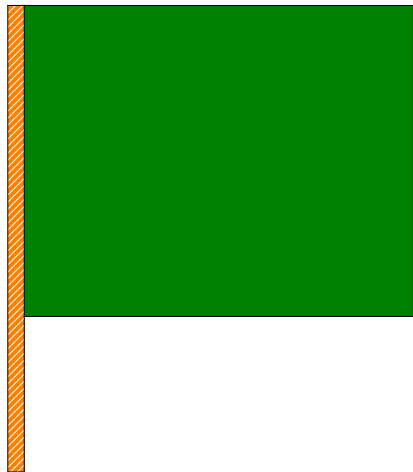
These rules can be modified without notice. These rules are intended as a guide for the conduct of the sport and are in no way a guarantee against any injury, serious injury, death or otherwise to participants, spectators or others.

- i. TRACK REGISTRATION - All participants must register and pay all associated track fees before using the track for competition and/or practice daily. All participants of Kartright Speedway must complete the Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk and

Indemnity Agreement (by reading, signing and dating) before being allowed to use the track.

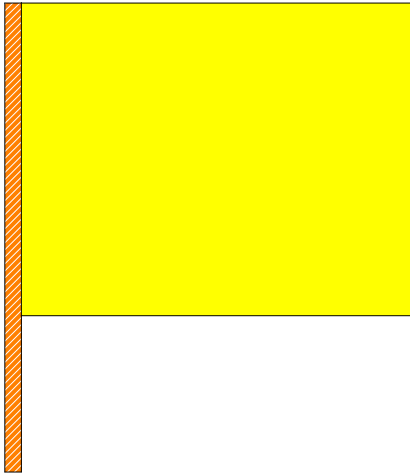
- ii. **CONDUCT** - All members shall conduct themselves in an orderly manner. Physical violence or verbal abuse of, or by, any individual, participant, spectator, etc. will subject the offender to immediate ejection from the event site, and possible suspension or ban of future participation. Members must participate in a safe and competitive manner with the understanding and attitude of safety first - racing second.
- iii. **PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES & GOOD HEALTH** - All members entering the restricted areas shall be sober and not under the influence of any substance that could impair their ability to participate in a safe and orderly manner. Any person who appears to be under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs will not be permitted to drive and will not be entitled to a refund. It is the responsibility of all participants to be in good health, both physically and mentally, as to not hinder the safety of other competitors. Smoking is strictly prohibited in the pit area and the track.
- iv. **SPONSORSHIP AND/OR ADVERTISEMENTS** - Kartright Speedway reserves the right to stipulate, refuse and/or demand removal of vehicle, trailer, helmet, clothing, etc. sponsorship and/or advertisements they deem inappropriate or offensive.
- v. **SELLING AND/OR SOLICITING** - No person(s) is permitted to sell or solicit on Kartright Speedway premises / properties without prior approval. No person is to use Kartright Speedway's documentation and/or information to sell or solicit to members without approval.
- vi. **DRIVER APPAREL/GEAR** - Full face helmet is recommended. If hair extends beneath the helmet level, it is mandatory that participants wear a balaclava or head sock. Track participants are also required to wear clothing that is consistent with the activity. Full apparel specifically designed for kart racing is recommend. Drivers must wear covered footwear; slippers, sandals or heels will not be allowed.
- vii. **ACCESS TO RESTRICTED AREAS** - Persons entering the grid and/or restricted areas must comply with all insurance regulations and registration procedures. Only drivers with "paid" wristbands and registered mechanics are allowed in the pit area.
- viii. **SPORTSMAN-LIKE DRIVING** - The spirit and intent of sportsman like racing competition is to proceed on the track without touching or endangering fellow participants. Also give racing room. Caution must be exercised when overtaking. It is the responsibility of the overtaking participant to pass in a safe fashion.

- ix. **COMPULSORY EQUIPMENT** - All karts must have CIK homologated rear wheel protection installed before being allowed on the track.
- x. **DIRECTION OF TRAVEL** - It is mandatory that all competitors strictly observe the direction of travel around a track.
- xi. **STOPPING ON COURSE** - If for any reason a competitor is forced to stop on/or near the course during practice, qualifying or racing, it is the responsibility of the competitor to assist in removal of the vehicle to a safety zone as quickly as possible.
- xii. **RE-ENTRY TO COURSE** - Karts entering the track are to do so without hindering the progress of karts already on track. When a participant enters the racing surface at a point as far from the racing line as possible.
- xiii. **OFFICIAL FLAGS (Practice / Track Days)** - It's important that drivers are aware of the location of flag posts, and are familiar with what each flag signal means.



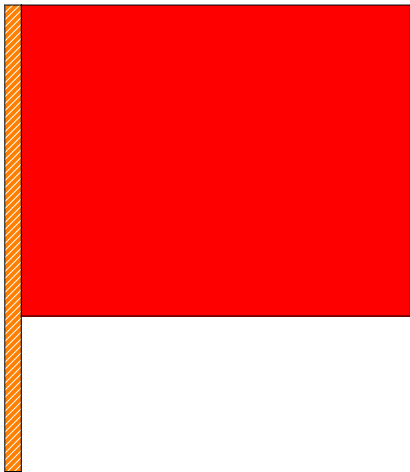
GREEN

Used to start the race, or practice sessions.



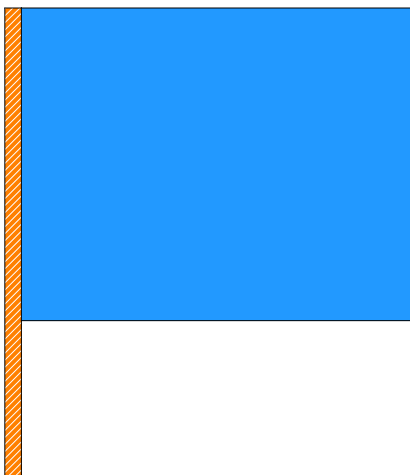
YELLOW

Slow down, use caution, and hold your position, no passing.



RED

Drivers must stop racing immediately, slow down and proceed in single file into the pit bay.

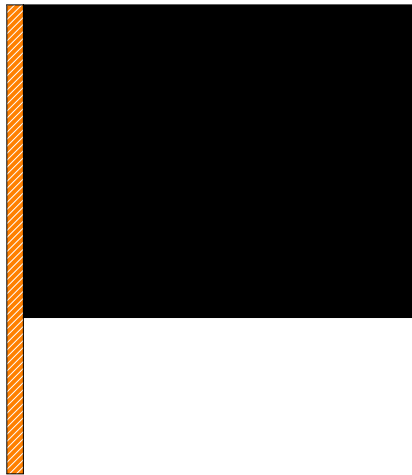


BLUE

This flag is normally be waved, as an indication to a Driver that he is about to be lapped/overtaken.

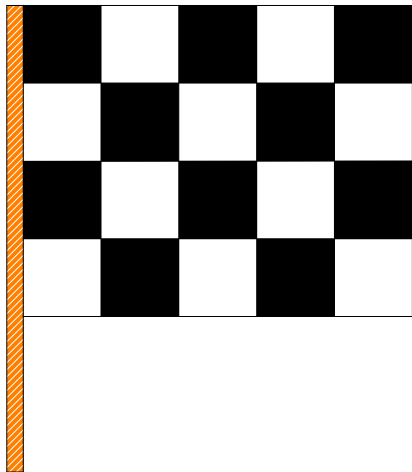
KAWASAKI

The Black Flag means that you have been disqualified for a driving problem and must exit the track immediately.



CHECKERED FLAG

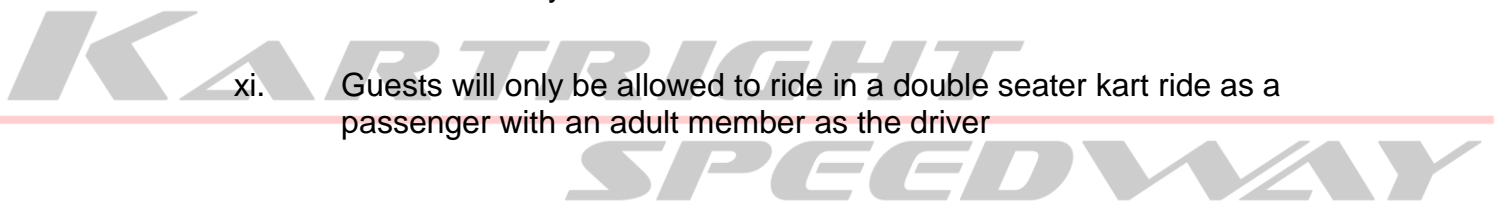
End of session / race.

3.2 Rental Karts

- i. The following rules are designed for the safety and enjoyment of all participants. Please observe and respect these rules as we wish everyone a safe and pleasurable experience at Kartright Speedway.
- ii. The Management reserves the right to refuse the rental of karts to any persons, without assigning any reasons.
- iii. All drivers must wear close-toed shoes and preferably long trousers.
- iv. All drivers must have wristbands to enter the kart track.

- v. Contact/bumping between karts is strictly not allowed. Any driver bumping another kart will be red flagged and his rental period will be immediately terminated, without any refund.
- vi. Any driver deemed driving in a dangerous manner will have his rental period immediately terminated without any refund.
- vii. Any person who appears to be under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs will not be permitted to drive and will not be entitled to a refund.
- viii. All karting is undertaken at the risk of the karter, and the management will not be responsible in any way for injury, damage or death caused during karting.
- ix. The management reserves the right to seek compensation for damage to karts, caused by the karter.
- x. All members or guests must be able to reach the pedals and fit the Kart comfortably. Strictly no tip-toeing will be allowed, including passenger. One will not be allowed to drive or act as a passenger in the 2 seater Kart should any of the above mentioned criteria not be met.

- xi. Guests will only be allowed to ride in a double seater kart ride as a passenger with an adult member as the driver



4.0 GYMNASIUM BYE-LAWS

4.1 REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

Members shall sign in and out of the Registration Book in the Gymnasium before and after using the Gymnasium.

4.2 JUNIOR MEMBERS

Junior members below the age of 12 shall not be allowed to use the Gymnasium. Those under 16 years old shall obtain their parent's consent and be accompanied by the parent/guardian when in the Gymnasium.

4.3 PROHIBITION

- (a) No equipment shall be removed from the Gymnasium.
- (b) Food & beverages are not allowed in the Gymnasium.

4.4 GENERAL

- (a) Members are requested to wipe clean the equipment they use and return them to their respective places after use

(b) The Club official is authorised to stop anyone from continuing his/her training if he/she is judged unfit.

(c) Members are advised to seek medical advice or assessment before starting on an exercise programme.

(d) Members are limited to only use each fitness equipment / station for no more than 20 minutes.

(e) Members are urged to report any damage of equipment to the Club Official immediately.

(f) The Club reserves the right to close the Gymnasium or any machine/facility within the Gymnasium, without prior notice, if such action is deemed necessary.

(g) All members and guests must be in appropriate attire, footwear with their personal towel in order to use the Gymnasium.

(h) The Club reserves the right to refuse the entry of any members or guests into the Gymnasium should they be in inappropriate attire.

(i) All members and guests using the Gymnasium is at entirely at their own risk. The Club and management shall not be held responsible for any loss, injury or death caused from using the equipment in the Gymnasium.

(j) Loud music and radio is not allowed in Gymnasium, only music player with headphone or earpiece will be allowed.

(k) There can only be up to 3 person using the Gymnasium at one time.

(l) The Gymnasium includes the following equipment

- Jogging Treadmill
- Free Weights
- Exercise Bicycle
- Rowing Machine

5.0 RENTAL OF LOCKERS BYE-LAWS

5.1 The Management shall determine the charges for the rental of the various lockers from time to time without prior notice.

5.2 Rental of lockers is subject to availability and is on a daily, first-come-first-served basis.

5.3 The Club shall not be liable for the loss of any article or property stored in a locker. Money, valuables, personal effects and other properties placed in the lockers shall be at the sole risk of the members.

5.4 Members shall be liable for a penalty charge as determined by the Management for replacement of a lost key or damaged locker.

5.5 Members failing to return their keys at the expiry of the rental period shall be billed a penalty charge as determined by the Management.

5.6 Members are to remove all their belongings in their lockers upon the expiry of the rental period, after which the Club shall have the right to remove and forfeit all the contents in the lockers without prior notice.

5.7 The Club shall not be responsible for the contents in the lockers.

5.8 No food or beverages, inflammable material, or petroleum is permitted to be stored in the lockers.

5.9 The Club reserves the right to conduct spot checks on the contents in the lockers in the presence of any of the Club's employees.

6.0 LOUNGE BYE-LAWS

6.1 ADMISSION

Admission to the lounge area will be subjected to bookings and approval.

6.3 PROHIBITIONS

(a) Serving of catered food / buffet will require the approval of the management

(b) Any damages caused during the usage of the lounge area would be taken as vandalism and members and/or their guests who are guilty of such acts shall be disciplined by the Club in accordance with the Club Constitution and are liable to pay for the damages caused.

6.4 GENERAL

(a) The malfunctioning of any machine / equipment is to be reported to the Club official immediately.

7.0 JOINING FEE

The Club's joining fees shall be as follow:

8.0 KART STORAGE BYE-LAWS

8.1 All storage fees are payable every quarter, in advance.

8.2 A refundable deposit of \$300 is required during storage registration.

8.3 All karts, engines and accessories are stored at the member's own risk. Kartright Speedway shall not be liable for any loss or damage, whatsoever or howsoever arising.

8.4 The Club shall have a lien over any karts and/or all equipment in storage, should any member fail to pay the storage fees after 60 days.

8.5 Members will not be entitled to draw their karts or equipment from the store if they have any outstanding storage dues.

8.6 A credit card authorization form with valid credit card details would be required for storage dues.

8.7 Transaction for storage dues will be made on the first week after the expiry date. Should the transaction be unsuccessful, the Club will contact the member via the contact information provided by the member. A notification email will be sent for every successful transaction made.

8.8 A member will be required to give 30days notice for termination of storage service. All monies paid in advance will be refundable together with the deposit within the next 30 calendar days via cheque.

8.9 All storage of karts is strictly for personal use only and cannot be used for commercial exploitation of any kind whatsoever.

9.0 USE OF CLUB FACILITIES BY CLUB EMPLOYEES

9.1 The usage of the Club's facilities is extended to its employees.

9.2 Employees are granted full access to all the Club's facilities.

9.3 Prior approval must be sought from the Management for any changes of the guidelines on the use of the track.
